HOW TO ORDER APPLE TREES & RASPBERRIES

Step 1 For Apples - Choose your varieties

Nearly all apple varieties require a pollinator, that is another apple variety nearby to donate pollen. It is possible to get by without a pollinator in suburban areas if there are other apples planted close by, but by planting a suitable pollinator a more certain and heavier fruit set is likely.

Choose trees with the same pollination group number for satisfactory cross pollination. Those with adjacent numbers will usually pollinate each other.

Triploid varieties, marked * in the Stock List, are an exception - they need a pollinator, but will not provide viable pollen for another variety. Some varieties self-pollinate, marked † in the Stock List, but perform better with a pollination partner.

A number of varieties have multiple uses and appear in more than one of the category lists below.

Our Collections (listed at the back of this catalogue) consist of suitable pollination partners. Otherwise use the Stock List in the following pages to choose compatible varieties. Make a note of the Variety Name and Stock Code for each tree required to avoid confusion if we can't

Step 1 for Raspberries - Choose your varieties

Raspberries are self pollinating so any single or combination of varieties will set fruit.

Step 4 Dispatch

Plants will be dispatched after cheques have cleared or funds have reached our account. Bare-root plants are sent by Australia Post during July and August. While dormant bare-root plants can survive in the packaging for more than a week, the sooner they are unpacked and healed-in** after their arrival the better. Keep packaged plants out of direct sun in the meantime. We will notify you by email when your Order is dispatched.
